

Implementation Guidelines for the KUDIS Concentration Certification Program

Entacted on March 1, 2023

Partially amended on September 1, 2023

<CIS Office>

Article 1 (Purpose) The purpose of this guideline is to stipulate regulations regarding the concentration certification of the Division of International Studies of the College of International Studies (hereinafter referred to as "DIS").

Article 2 (Concentration) ① The concentrations to be administered by DIS are as follows:

1. International Commerce
2. International Politics
3. International Development and Cooperation

② DIS may implement or remove concentrations based on the review of the DIS undergraduate curriculum committee.

Article 3 (Certificate Requirements) ① The curriculum and other requirements for each concentration shall be in accordance with [Attachment 1] 'Concentration List.'

② A student of DIS may pursue more than one concentration. However, he or she cannot postpone graduation to complete a concentration if all graduation requirements other than certificate requirements have been met.

③ DIS may change at any time the requirements for the concentration based on the review of the DIS undergraduate curriculum committee.

Article 4 (Application Qualifications and Procedures) ① The following students are eligible to apply for the concentration certification: Students in the Division of International Studies (including those who are in Interdisciplinary Studies), and students of intensive majors, double majors, and dual degree programs.

② Students are eligible to apply between confirmation of their grades for the second semester of the first year and confirmation of their grades for the final semester prior to graduation. In order

to apply for the concentration certificate, students must submit each of the following documents to the DIS administration office during application periods.

1. Concentration certificate application form
2. Concentration Receipt *Amended on September 1, 2023*

Article 5 (Certificate and Graduation Requirements) ① Students in the Division of International Studies (including those who are in Interdisciplinary Studies), and students of intensive majors, double majors, and dual degree programs are required to complete at least one concentration before confirmation of their grades for the final semester prior to graduation.

Article 6 (Awarding Certificates) ① The DIS undergraduate curriculum committee shall review whether an applicant who has submitted the required documents is eligible for the certificate.

② DIS shall award a concentration certificate based on the review of the DIS undergraduate curriculum committee.

Article 7 (Other matters) Any matters not specified in this guideline may be determined subsequently through the review of the DIS undergraduate curriculum committee.

Supplementary Provisions

1. (Effective Date) These guidelines will take effect on May 1, 2023.
2. (Transitional measures) The new concentration program also applies to students who have taken courses prior to the effective date. Students who are expecting to graduate in August 2023 (including candidates) are eligible to apply for the concentration certificate. A completion certificate will be issued after deliberation.

Supplementary Provisions

(Date of Enforcement) The amended regulation shall be apply from September 1, 2023. (Article 4 amended)
